

RE: SY 2016-17 R.E.A.C.H. Initiative Award Approval

On behalf of Lieutenant Governor Shan S. Tsutsui, I am pleased to inform you that Waianae Intermediate School and Nanakuli High and Intermediate School have been selected to receive SY16/17 Resources for Enrichment, Athletics, Culture and Health (R.E.A.C.H.) funding in the amount of \$91,692 to continue the Waianae, Nanakuli Complex Middle School Athletics Initiative and for non-instructional hours programming consistent with the intent and objectives of the R.E.A.C.H. Initiative and the goals and outcomes set forth in your grant application.

The Department of Education (DOE) will allocate state general funds appropriated for the R.E.A.C.H. Initiative to your school account. Schools are required to comply with DOE procurement policies and procedures.

As a condition of being awarded the R.E.A.C.H. grant, schools are required to send their R.E.A.C.H. Coordinator to the mandatory one day workshop to be held at the State Capitol in Honolulu on Wednesday, September 7, 2016 from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. A workshop schedule is forthcoming.

At some point in the grant term, the Office of the Lieutenant Governor, DOE, and the Office of Youth Services will conduct a site visit to review and evaluate the grantee's records, activities, organizational procedures and conduct interviews and provide technical assistance as necessary. Throughout the term of the grant, the R.E.A.C.H. Logo will be displayed on the grantee's website homepage with a hyperlink to the R.E.A.C.H. website.
