**Ulua Lagoon 4 Sand Reclamation and Beautification Work:
January 18, 2018 – February 16, 2018 (Or Upon Earlier Completion of Work)**

Overview

- Ko Olina Community Association (KOCA) will perform an extensive sand reclamation and beach beautification project on Ulua Lagoon 4 from Thursday, January 18th through Friday, February 16th (or upon earlier completion of the work).
- ***The Ulua Lagoon beach (makai of the pedestrian walkway) and public parking lot will be closed for the duration of the project.***
- Work is scheduled in January to avoid peak travel periods.

Description of Work

- Sand reclamation and beautification work will restore the Lagoon 4 beach, which has experienced some erosion since its opening over 20 years ago.
 - Reclamation work includes erosion remedy, mitigation of problem areas and sand replenishment.
 - Beach beautification work includes sand grooming to create a more usable and stable beach.
 - Parking lot and landscaping work includes deep cleaning, re-numbering of stalls, landscape maintenance activities and, tree trimming.
- Sea Engineering, Inc., Hawaii's leading marine construction and coastal engineering specialist, will be overseeing sand reclamation efforts. They are extremely familiar with the resort, having consulted on several Ko Olina projects prior.

Shoreline work is being done through current permits with the United States Army Corps of Engineers and Department of Health Clean Water Branch.

- Advisory signs have been posted at the entrance to the resort and Ulua Lagoon parking lot; additionally, the resort's website (<http://koolina.com/destination/lagoons/>) and mobile app have been updated to advise of the repair and beautification work.
- Daily use and operational hours at all other lagoons, beaches and public parking lots, are not affected.
